COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

We will continue our learning to ensure we are confident to be able to speak in full sentences. We will be learning some facts about different animals and countries. We are also going to practice being a weather forecaster.

LITERACY

We will be doing still be doing lots of writing this half term. We will be focusing on applying our phonics knowledge to our writing. We will be creating our own short stories and thinking about the different places our stories could be set.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

We will be learning all about different countries from around the world. We will be looking at hot countries and cold countries and the different animals that live in these countries.

We will also be looking at the different foods that are eaten across the world and trying some of these foods to see if we like the different tastes.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Our Jigsaw piece this half term is called relationships. We will be looking at making friends and how we make friends. What makes a kind friend. We will also be looking at bullying and falling out and strategies to cope and help us deal with these situations.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

We will be continuing our learning about keeping our bodies healthy in lots of different ways. we will be working hard to ensure our letters are formed correctly in our writing.

In PE we will be focusing on ball skills and handeye co-ordination.

MUSIC
